CargoWise™ edi Certified as ABI Vendor with U.S. Customs & Border Protection

CargoWise edi Meets 100-Point Test Plan; Receives Certification from CBP

Chicago, IL USA, September 24, 2007 — CargoWise™ edi, a leading provider of integrated international supply chain logistics management systems, has recently been certified as an Automated Broker Interface (ABI) vendor with the U.S. Customs & Border Protection (CBP) Agency.

After integrating the necessary CBP messaging capabilities for combined International Freight Forwarders and Customs House Brokers into its edi*Enterprise* software solution, CargoWise edi successfully completed the intensive testing and qualification with the CBP Automated Commercial System (ACS). The Company is now approved for the following levels of ABI operations: ABI (Import Customs House Broker), MQ-SV (MQ/Frame enabled ABI software vendor) and QP/WP (In-bond messaging services).

The certification confirms that CargoWise edi has successfully passed the stringent 100-point test plan developed by the U.S. CBP Agency. The certification includes messaging capabilities such as: Automated Broker Interface (ABI) and In-Bond (IT – QP/WP) capabilities, which allows import data to be filed electronically via edi*Enterprise*, CargoWise edi's modular set of supply chain solutions, directly with Customs using the Automated Commercial System (ACS).

The benefits of CBP certification is apparent to the customers who have an integrated end-to-end solution for the International Freight Forwarding and Customs House Brokerage community that is capable of ABI and In-bond messaging. The integration with CBP expedites the release of merchandise for the trade community, as entry summaries are electronically transmitted, validated, confirmed, amended and paid. Administrative messages keep participants informed on all current information and processing status. Users can also query quota status, visa requirements, importer, supplier, manufacturer information, and pay Customs duties, fees and taxes (statements) through the Automated Clearing House (ACH). The system also allows for Remote Location Filing (RLF), which provides the ability to file import data from a remote location.

Through the use of CargoWise edi's edi*Enterprise* software system, ACS facilitates merchandise processing, significantly cuts costs and reduces paperwork requirements for both Customs and the importing community. This adds to the existing capabilities with the Shippers Export Declarations and AMS Import Containers that are already live and in use by CargoWise edi's edi*Enterprise* customer base. The edi*Enterprise* system provides a seamless single point of data entry for all international shipment messages.
